

## Invasive plants

In this section we looked at invasive plant species, comparing invasive alien plant species (IAPS) listed in four global databases: CAB International Invasive Species Compendium (CABI 2016), the Global Invasive Species Database compiled by the IUCN Invasive Species Specialist Group (ISSG 2015), invasive trees and shrubs (Richardson and Rejmánek 2011; Rejmánek and Richardson 2013) and IAPS in natural areas (Weber 2003).
